



Shocks & Struts

How do you know if you need new shocks or struts? Here at Buehler Automotive & transmission we believe that informed customers are our best allies. When driving you will begin to notice deterioration in the handling of your vehicle as your shocks and struts begin to fail. Unchecked, this can lead to higher repair costs, potentially damaging your exhaust system, transmission or engine oil pans, radiator mounts or other under car components due to bottoming out of the suspension.

You will begin to notice

- Roll or sway on turns
- Front end "dives" when braking
- Rear end "squats" when accelerating
- Excessive bouncing or sideways slides on rough roads
- Your vehicle "bottoming out" or scrapes the roadway

Once you bring it to Buehler Automotive & Transmission the first things that we look for are:

- Leaks on shocks or strut housings
- Dents or physical damage on the strut or shock body
- Worn or missing rubber mounting bushings
- Abnormal tire wear
- Damaged compression bumpers
- Damaged protective dust boots
